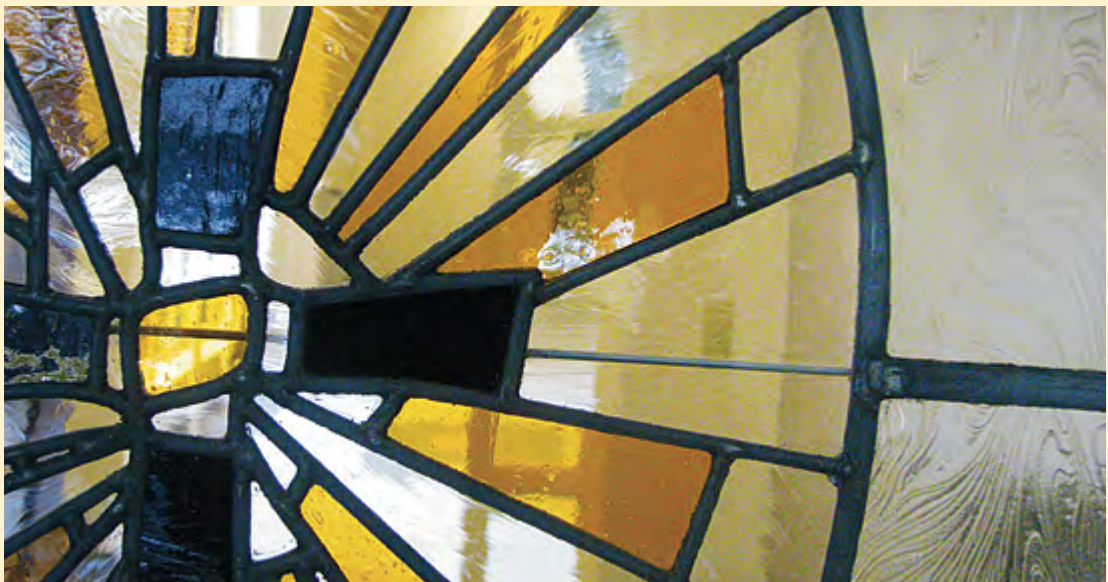


Mission

Cristo Rey Jesuit High School prepares each and every student for college. Our strong academic program challenges students to achieve at the highest levels. Cristo Rey Jesuit's outstanding faculty is dedicated to guiding our students to bright futures. Like many other private schools, we require four years of English, theology, mathematics, and science, three years of social studies and two years of language study. Advanced Placement courses in English, world history, and Spanish and honors courses in mathematics, Spanish, English and history are available to top students. Admission to Cristo Rey Jesuit's chapter of the National Honor Society is open to students who demonstrate academic excellence, leadership, character and service.

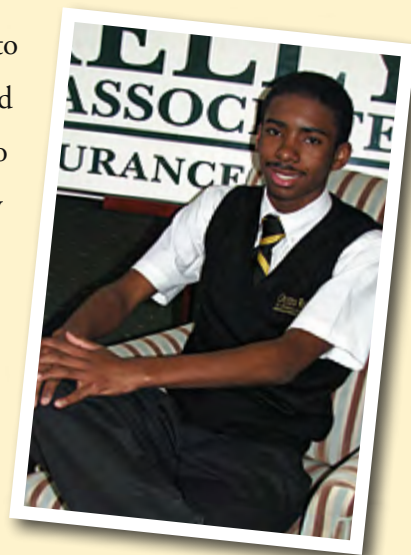
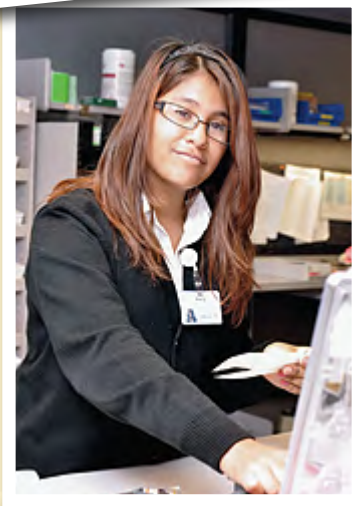

Cristo Rey Jesuit is a safe, friendly school community located in the heart of historic Fells Point. Our Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Academic Center is the pride of our campus, with a 4,000 volume library, four high-tech classrooms, and a college counseling center. A three-story glass-enclosed walkway connects the Weinberg Center with Healy Hall. The historic stone structure boasts recently added physics, chemistry and biology laboratories, a brand-new student lounge, a health suite staffed by a full-time nurse, and a counseling center. A brick courtyard nestled between Healy and Weinberg provides a quiet space for students to gather, pray and reflect.

Our students have access to a 27-station Macintosh computer lab and 80 wireless laptops. All 25 classrooms are equipped with LCD projectors and whiteboards. Twelve classrooms feature the latest SMART Board technology, allowing students and teachers to work interactively. Every student has a school email account, and the school's Edline sites give students and families access to grades and assignments from any location. Our technology-rich environment reflects what students will find on a college campus. It's one more way we prepare students for bright and promising futures.

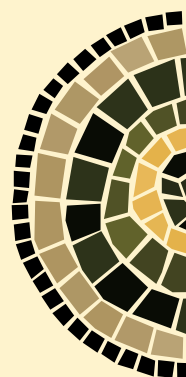

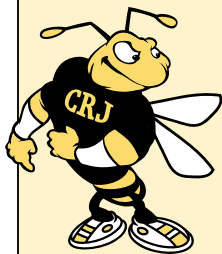
