Dear Cristo Rey Jesuit Families,

In light of the recent multiple snows and lost time from school, we plan to take steps to keep our academic and work programs as strong as they can be from now until the end of the school year.

First, the Extended Day Program, as it is now set up, will be discontinued on Friday, February 26th. As of Monday, March 1st, students who remain at Cristo Rey Jesuit after school will need to be in a supervised activity. Those students who are not involved in a school club or sport, and are simply waiting for their rides, must go to the new "Late Study" room where they will be doing school work or reading. Families will continue to pick up their children from the back of the school, on Castle Street, but students will no longer wait for their rides on the stage. This is in part due to the fact that the stage is being renovated shortly. In addition, the Late Study program will be staffed by our Jesuit volunteers, who will be able to assist students with their assignments, and maintain the academic atmosphere we are working to uphold in our school. The afternoon shuttle will continue to depart from the back gate daily at 5:15 p.m.

Second, we will be adding two school days to our school calendar, by coming back two days early from Easter Break. We will still go on Easter Break at the end of the day on Wednesday, March 31st, but we will return from Easter Break on the morning of Thursday, April 8th. Thursday, April 8th and Friday, April 9th will be regular Week 4 school and work days. Please note that on Friday, April 9th, Thursday workers will go to work that day. With this adjustment to our calendar, staff and students will still receive a full week off, but we will also be able to diminish the number of instructional and work days lost to inclement weather.

As always, we feel blessed to work with Cristo Rey Jesuit families, and we thank you in advance for your partnership and support of our program as we work to make it the best it can be.
