Dear CRJ families,

As we prepare to safely open our doors on Monday, August 23 for the first day of school, we are reaching out to you today to let you know that our records indicate that your child has not yet received the Covid-19 vaccine, which is a requirement for enrollment in Cristo Rey Jesuit for the 2021-2022 school year. If our records are not correct, please send a picture of your child's Covid-19 vaccination card to Nurse Tatum at jtatum@cristoreybalt.org immediately.

To continue enrollment at Cristo Rey Jesuit, students must receive at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine by Monday, August 23 to ensure that we keep our community safe. CRJ is hosting its final, free vaccine clinic in our school building on Saturday, August 21 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. You can sign up for the clinic here.

Students who have not received at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine by the start of school on Monday, August 23 will not be permitted to attend, and arrangements will be made for the student to be unenrolled from Cristo Rey Jesuit. If an unvaccinated student arrives at the school on August 23 or after, the student's parent or guardian will be contacted to arrange for their student's transportation home from the school grounds. If you do not intend to have your student vaccinated, please contact the school registrar, Chauntay Smith, csmith@cristoreybalt.org immediately to initiate the student withdrawal process for your child.
