

Dear CRJ Families and Students.

With students returning to in-person learning and resuming their internships, our school community's health and safety remains paramount. We want to ensure our community remains safe so that our students can safely enjoy the many exciting events and activities the second semester of school brings. As an added safety measure, we will be hosting another vaccine booster clinic at Cristo Rey Jesuit High School on Thursday, April 21, 2022 from 1:30pm-2:30pm in the Boardroom.

The Pfizer vaccine will be offered at the clinic. Students are eligible to receive their booster shot if it has been at least **5 months** since they received the second dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine.

Attached please find the Total Healthcare consent form for the booster clinic. Parents are not required to be present for their students to receive their booster, however, to enroll, **Sections 1 and 2 are required to be completed and sent to Nurse Tatum by Wednesday, April 20.**Completed forms can be emailed to me, faxed to 443-573-9884, or returned in-person to the school's front office. If your student has already received their COVID-19 booster, please email me documentation.

We strongly encourage all eligible students to receive their booster shot as it is the strongest defense against severe illness from COVID-19 and its variants. Additionally, as the COVID pandemic continues to evolve, many of our corporate partners are updating their safety protocols, now requiring all employees, including our CIP interns, to have received their booster shot in order to continue working in the office. Additionally, all students will receive an <u>iHealth</u> COVID-19 rapid test kit to bring home this week. Each test kit contains 2 tests. These COVID-19 tests can be used at home as needed, but are primarily sent home to be used during spring break. If your child is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms during spring break, please test them before returning to school on Tuesday, April 19th.
